All new wiring and new plumbing, (to bring the entire house up to code) is in progress. Work will continue with sheet rocking, flooring, installation of replacement windows, new kitchen and painting. The entire kitchen to include cabinets, counters and appliances had to be totally replaced. Finished completion date is June 1st or before for the arrival of the Summer ministers.
