
The Harding Point Cemetery Great Cranberry Island, Maine





The Harding Point Cemetery is situated in a quiet secluded spot, close to the shore on Harding Point, the northeastern corner of the island. Starting from the Town Dock, go about 0.25 miles down the main road to the first paved road on the left, just past the tennis court, which is Harding Point Road -- although there's no sign to indicate it. Then go about 0.3 miles down that winding road until you come to telephone pole #22, just before the end of the asphalt paving. There you will see a dirt road that bears off to the right. Go down that road until you come to the second dirt driveway leading off to the left, which is just by telephone pole #2 1/2. Enter the driveway, and the cemetery is about 100 yards in, on the left

-- before you come to the associated house.

The Harding Point Cemetery is rectangular in shape, 57 feet long and 39 feet wide. It is not surrounded by a fence. Instead, there are turned wooden posts, painted white, at each corner, with three additional similar posts along each side (16 posts in all) to give a sense of enclosure.

Within the cemetery, one memorial stone is mounted on a unique raised plot, consisting of a 12-foot square fieldstone walled enclosure about 1.5 feet high, filled with earth.

Inscriptions




All stones face west.





Apparently Capt. Manchester's stone (above) is a replacement to the original stone, which broke. The original broken stone was found while the Wadsworths were building their nearby house, and was built flat to the ground into the the path leading to the house. It carries the same information as the duplicate stone, but also has an inscription, as follows:

The day is past and gone, The evening shades appear, Oh may we all remember well, The night of death draws near.

[The Harding stone is mounted on top of the perimeter of a 12-foot by 12-foot stone enclosure, similar to a small fence, 1.5 feet tall. The enclosure is filled with earth. There is a flag poked into the earth behind the stone.]

NOTES:

On the east side of the cemetery, loosely scattered on the ground, are the following items:

- footstone "E. M. S." very clearly carved. But no headstone bears a name matching these initials; this is a mystery.
- footstone "S. S. F." apparently of Samuel S. Fernald.

 Although there is apparently no stone for him, he is mentioned on <u>B-4</u>, the stone of his wife, Margaret S. Fernald. He probably died after his wife and was buried near or next to her without his own stone.
- footstone "G. J. S." apparently of Gilman J. Stanley, <u>B-3</u>.

 The middle initial is not very clear, it just looks like a straight vertical line; the hook of the "J" is not too pronounced, but it is probably a "J".



Table of Names in Alphabetical Order

This table duplicates all the names mentioned in the inscriptions, but here they're in alphabetical order by family name, so you can find a particular name easily by eye.

Please be aware that a person may be mentioned on more than one inscription. They may have their own stone, as well as being mentioned on another stone as "son of ..." or "father of ..." for example. However, the table has only one link to an inscription. It may not be the only reference. So study the inscriptions carefully for multiple references.

Stones with "dau. of ..." are especially useful as they reveal a woman's maiden name. Where possible, I've listed women under both their maiden and married names.

Family members were often buried close to each other.
